HOUSING PACKAGE

The price includes classes, on-campus accommodation, various cultural activities.
The price does not include the round trip plane ticket, meals and the bank transfer fees. A special rate is offered to students coming from partner universities.

ASSESSMENT

At the end of the training, participants will undertake assessment in all four courses. Each student receives a teaching report from the University of New Caledonia (UNC), a transcript mentioning the number of ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) credits obtained and a certificate of French level. They also have the opportunity to take the TCF test (Test de Connaissance du Français), official French certification valid 2 years (optional cost).

3 WEEKS TO IMPROVE YOUR FRENCH

This training, offered by the International Office of the University of New Caledonia (UNC), in cooperation with the faculty of the university, is aimed at a public of French-studying students who have a sufficient linguistic background to follow didactic-oriented courses. A B2 or B1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages is required.
